Cllr Awford reported that the main contract for Gloucestershire Highways had gone to Ringway from 2019. He mentioned A48 night time closures in October for road repairs. Also reported was the TBC Local Plan which is now out for consultation; the JCS review is next for discussion, but currently there is no further housing projected for Highnam.

15. To discuss and decide on Allotment Association request for additional shed

Clerk explained request for additional storage purposes; it was agreed by all that this could be approved.

16. To discuss Lassington Lane Hedge

A request had been received that Parish Council support a private arrangement between Bellway Homes and residents of Lassington Lane that the hedge on the southern side of the exit from Lassington Reach be allowed to grow up to approximately 4.5m height. This was agreed and Council will write to Bellway advising them of this decision.
